We'll fly non-stop into Sunny San Jose. Welcome to wine country and Clos LaChance Winery... Enjoy lunch and a tasting at this beautiful award-winning winery. We'll make our way to Monterey and our home for the night... the Best Western Victorian Inn. Monterey was the capital of Alta during the 1700's and 1800's... you'll find historical influence of both Spain and Mexico here. Your evening is free to explore, we are close to Cannery Row... full of shops, eateries and more!

We'll head south down beautiful Highway 1 today first Stop... Julia Burns State Park - Named after Julia Pfeiffer Burns, a well-respected pioneer rancher in the early 20th century, it stretches from the Big Sur coastline into nearby ridges. A main feature of the park is McWay Falls, which drops 80 feet into the Pacific Ocean. Next enjoy Lunch and some spectacular views at Coast Big Sur Restaurant. We'll continue down beautiful Highway 1 to our home for the next two nights the Blue Sail Inn, Morrow Bay... situated on a bluff overlooking Morro Rock and the Embarcadero. Tonight, enjoy a wonderful dinner cruise about the Chablis... a unique, 50-foot, two-story riverboat that graces the gentle waters of beautiful Morro Bay.

Welcome to Hearst Castle, a National Historic Landmark! William Randolph Hearst told architect Julia Morgan that he wanted to build "a little something" on the California Coast... A 165-room Moorish castle with 127 acres of gardens, terraces, pools and walkways, furnished with Spanish and Italian antiques and art, flanked by three large guest houses! In its heyday, Hearst Castle had a zoo, tennis courts and two magnificent swimming pools. We'll indulge in a wonderful lunch here before we head San Luis Obispo. We'll take in some of California's heritage at to one of California's most beautiful missions, Mission San Luis Obispo de Tolosa. Enjoy some free time here before we head back to Morrow Bay where your evening is free to explore the shops and eateries.

After breakfast we'll head to everyone's favorite city, you know, the "city by the bay"... San Francisco! First stop, San Juan Bautista for lunch and some free time... Rich with culture and history, it offers a small-town atmosphere filled with the charm and character of the past. Our home for the next two nights is the Hotel Zephyr Fisherman's Warf with its playful personality... it's just steps away from Pier 39, Ghirardelli Square and the Alcatraz ferry landing. Settle in and relax before a welcome dinner at one of Pier 39's wonderful restaurants.
