Enjoy 50.5 miles of a crystal clear, glacier-fed lake, surrounded by vineyards, mountains and small-town charm that promises an array of unique activities. Throughout July and August, Leavenworth Summer Theater turns the Ski Hill and the Fish Hatchery into centers for theater. Ski hill? Fish hatchery? That's right! Every summer you can see "The Sound of Music" at the Ski Hill Amphitheater.

We'll make our way through the beautiful Columbia River Gorge today with a few stops along the way including the **City of Toppenish**, where you'll have some free time for lunch and to view their murals. We'll continue over rugged Stevens Pass before descending into the glacier-carved Chelan Wine Valley... as we approach admire massive Lake Chelan that is flanked by wooded hillsides and acres of rolling vineyards. Our home for the next two nights is **beautiful Lakefront Lodge** featuring lake views. You'll have some time to rest up before **dinner at Tsillan Cellars** on the shores of stunning Lake Chelan.



This morning enjoy a **cruise on Lake Chelan aboard The Lady of the Lake II**. She has a spacious deck for outdoor viewing and transports you in style. The Captain provides light narration on the folklore and points of interest. **Welcome to Stehekin...** it is a breathtaking destination nestled deep in the heart of the North Cascades. You'll have time to explore the landing area including the National Park Visitor Center. The valley is surrounded by peaks of the North Cascades. We'll make our return trip to Chelan where **dinner awaits at Karma Vineyards** featuring lovely lake views and great food.

Enjoy a Leisurely morning to soak up the views from your balcony or take a walk along the lake before we say goodbye to breathtaking Lake Chelan. Next, it's the **Chelan County Museum & Pioneer Village...** The village consists of 20 original structures. It showcases a one room schoolhouse, a Great Northern Railway caboos and more. **Lunch is served at the Milepost Brewery**. Our home for the next two nights the **Bavarian Inn** located in the heart of Leavenworth. Your **afternoon is free to explore**. Tonight, it's **The Sound of Music!** As the sun falls, the moon rises over the valley and Maria descends the hillside singing, "The Hills are Alive".

Today we'll head to **Red Tail Canyon Farm** where a **horse-drawn wagons ride awaits**. A draft horse team will lead us through the forests and fields into Red-Tail Canyon. We'll hear about the history of the area, how the horses are used for logging and farming the ranch. Afterward we'll **indulge in a traditional BBQs here...** we'll be served amongst the towering pines in their mammoth outdoor log lodge. Your afternoon is free to explore Leavenworth on your own... You'll find many wonderful shops, museums and more. Dinner tonight is at **Visconti's Ristorante Italian**. Now were set for **the Music Man...** Seventy-six trombones, a shipooi or two and some trouble in River City are all featured in this hilarious Golden Age classic... all under the stars at the Fish Hatchery Amphitheater.

First stop today is **Central Washington Agricultural Museum...** Its park-like surroundings are home to multitudes of horse drawn and early mechanical farm machinery, farm equipment and homesteads. **We'll indulge in a delicious catered lunch here before we head home with great memories of gorgeous Central Washington.**
