
Welcome to beach city... our home for the next **4 nights the Embassy Suites** in the heart of downtown. Get cozy in your suite before the **nightly Manager's Reception**. Next, we'll head to **Tom Ham's Lighthouse Restaurant**... A fully functioning lighthouse, known as Beacon #9 on USCG Nautical Maps, was incorporated into the design.

We'll start the day with a tour of **Hotel Del Coronado**... Built in 1888 and designated a National Historic Landmark in 1977, Hotel del Coronado is an American treasure with more than a century of stories to tell. The Del's founders, dreamed of building a seaside resort that would be "the talk of the Western world." Since then, the resort has become a living legend visited by celebrities, dignitaries, and U.S. presidents. Next, enjoy some **free time in historic Gaslamp Quarter** where you can stretch your legs and grab some lunch. Afterward, we'll continue our tour with a drive north of the city to admire the **spectacular coastline of La Jolla**, arguably the most picturesque part of the city. La Jolla boasts a natural cove that is home to sea caves, cliffs, abundant marine life, and local kayakers. **Dinner tonight is at Season's 52**... by sourcing ingredients at their peak of freshness, their chefs are able to transform them into memorable dishes year-round.

We'll start at the **USS Midway today**... Formerly the US Navy's longest-serving aircraft carrier (1945 to 1991), the USS Midway Museum comprises an entire floating city. Explore more than 60 exhibits as well as peek inside the museum's impressive aircraft collection. Next enjoy a **fun lunch in Old Town**... **Tacos, tequila & tombstones**... stroll at a leisurely pace, stopping at four top-rated eateries along the way. Taste delicious tacos, salsas, and fresh tortillas. You also get to sample cocktails made with tequila. With Old Town's long history, it has collected several ghost stories including El Campo Santo Cemetery and Whaley House, which "America's Most Haunted" named the most haunted house in America. Our last stop of the day is at **The Junípero Serra Museum**... an iconic regional landmark. It sits on one of the most significant historical sites on the West Coast, the site of the first permanent European settlement. **Your evening is free** to explore on your own... enjoy our wonderful location next to Seaport Village.

Today we'll take you to **Balboa Park**... More than 17 museums filled with everything from dinosaurs to space travel. It is also home to the world-famous San Diego Zoo. **Explore on your own and find what inspires you!** We'll meet up early afternoon and head to another San Diego "must see". **Cabrillo National Monument** offers a superb view of San Diego's harbor and skyline and includes Old Point Loma Lighthouse, a San Diego icon since 1854. You'll have some time to rest up and catch the Manager's Reception before our fantastic dinner at **Eddie V's Prime Seafood** they feature delicious, expertly prepared seafood and steaks.

It's time to go home but the fun isn't over... we take in a **harbor cruise** before heading to the airport. Enjoy a unique perspective of San Diego that you can only get from the water. **We head home with wonderful memories of beach city!**
