Enjoy three relaxing nights at the iconic Paradise Inn, surrounded by alpine meadows, wildflowers, and breathtaking mountain views. Each day offers a thoughtful balance of guided experiences and free time, from ranger talks and gentle walks to visits to waterfalls, reflection lakes, and historic sites. Take in sweeping vistas from the Crystal Mountain Gondola and savor the beauty of this remarkable region at a leisurely pace. Your adventure concludes with a powerful and inspiring visit to Mount St. Helens, where the story of nature's resilience comes to life—making this a truly memorable and enriching getaway.

Day 1 – Wednesday, August 26 | Mount Rainier & Scenic Railway Experience Your adventure begins in the Willamette Valley as we make our way north toward one of the Pacific Northwest's most iconic destinations—Mount Rainier. This afternoon, step back in time aboard the Mount Rainier Scenic Railroad, where vintage railcars and forested landscapes create a nostalgic journey through the foothills of the mountain. Following our rail excursion, we ascend into Mount Rainier National Park and arrive at the historic Paradise Inn, nestled high on the slopes of the mountain. With its rustic charm and spectacular setting, this lodge will be your home for the next three nights. Take time to relax, breathe in the crisp alpine air, and soak in your first views of this magnificent peak before gathering for a welcoming dinner. (L, D)

Day 2 – Thursday, August 27 | Paradise Meadows & Longmire Heritage Wake up surrounded by the beauty of Mount Rainier and enjoy breakfast at the lodge. This morning, join your Tour Director for a gentle, paved walk to Myrtle Falls, one of the park's most photographed viewpoints, or enjoy free time at your own pace. Late morning, gather for an engaging Ranger Talk, offering insight into the geology, wildlife, and history of this incredible national park. After time for lunch and exploration, journey to the historic Longmire district. Here, explore the Longmire Museum, stroll across the scenic Nisqually Suspension Bridge, and learn about the early days of Mount Rainier tourism. On our return, we pause at several stunning viewpoints, including Christine Falls and Ricksecker Point, offering sweeping vistas of valleys and peaks. Dinner this evening is again enjoyed at the Paradise Inn. (B, D)

Day 3 – Friday, August 28 | Waterfalls, Reflections, & Alpine Discovery Today is dedicated to experiencing Mount Rainier's most iconic scenery. After breakfast, set out for a morning of exploration, beginning with the powerful and

picturesque Narada Falls, followed by a visit to Reflection Lake, where still waters can create a perfect mountain reflection. We return to Paradise Inn for a relaxing midday break before heading out again for a Ranger-led Nature Walk through Paradise Meadows. This guided experience brings the landscape to life, highlighting wildflowers, wildlife, and the unique alpine ecosystem. Enjoy another relaxing evening and dinner at the lodge, surrounded by the quiet beauty of the mountain. (B, D)

Day 4 – Saturday, August 29 | Crystal Mountain Views After breakfast, bid farewell to Paradise and travel to nearby Crystal Mountain for one of the most breathtaking viewpoints in the region. A scenic gondola ride carries us high above the Cascades, where panoramic views of Mount Rainier and the surrounding peaks await. Enjoy time at the summit, including lunch with a view that is truly unforgettable. Later this afternoon, we descend into the charming mountain town of Packwood, where we check into our accommodations and enjoy a relaxed group dinner. (B, L, D)

Day 5 – Sunday, August 30 | Mount St. Helens Our final day offers one more incredible Pacific Northwest highlight as we travel toward Mount St. Helens. We begin with a visit to the Mount St. Helens Forest Learning Center, where exhibits tell the powerful story of the 1980 eruption and the region's recovery. Continuing on, we arrive at the remarkable Johnston Ridge Observatory, where you will stand face-to-face with the volcano's crater and gain a deeper understanding of this dramatic natural event. Following our visit, we begin our journey home with comfortable drop-offs in the Willamette Valley—bringing with us lasting memories of towering peaks, alpine beauty, and shared experiences. (B, L)
