# Shore Acres Holiday Lights 2026

**3 Days / 2 Nights December 17-19, 2026**

## **Day 1 - Wednesday, December 17, 2026 - South Along the Coast**

## **Day 2 - Thursday, December 18, 2026 - Cape Arago, Sea Lions, & Holiday Lights**

Today showcases the very best of Oregon's South Coast. After breakfast, we visit the Charleston Marine Life Center to discover the fascinating creatures that inhabit the rocky Pacific shoreline. Lunch follows at Fisherman's Grotto along Cape Arago Highway before meeting local guide Marty Giles for a beach walk in search of colorful glass floats and views of the Steller sea lions at Simpson's Reef. As evening falls, we arrive at Shore Acres State Park for the highlight of the tour

— more than 325,000 holiday lights illuminating the gardens and dramatic oceanfront cliffs. With reserved group access and dinner back at hotel, it is a memorable day along the Oregon Coast. (B, L, D)

## **Day 3 - Friday, December 19, 2026 - Heceta Head, Newport, & Home**

After breakfast, we begin our journey north along one of Oregon's most scenic coastal highways. Our first stop is historic Heceta Head Lighthouse, where sweeping ocean views showcase one of the coast's most iconic landmarks. We then continue to Newport for lunch at a waterfront restaurant before enjoying free time to explore the Bayfront's shops, galleries, and working harbor. By afternoon, we board the coach for the drive home, bringing with us memories of holiday lights, coastal scenery, and a festive South Coast escape. (B, L)
